

Clayton County Business Community Meeting August 26, 2010 – 6:00 p.m.

Clayton County is currently conducting a Disparity Study. The principal purpose of the Study is to analyze and evaluate current contracting practices of the County in the areas of goods, services, and construction. A successful disparity study requires the involvement of market area businesses willing and able to perform public contracts. In order to **inform the business community about the Disparity Study**, the County is sponsoring a business community meeting.

At the meeting an overview of the disparity study process will be presented and County managers will discuss upcoming contracting opportunities and provide a comment period for businesses to share their contracting experiences.

Mason Tillman Associates, Ltd. is conducting the Disparity Study with assistance from its local subconsultant, RJ Littles & Associates.
